Which features do the Poplars offer me?

The Poplars are a modern interpretation of the iconic Dutch wooden shoe, made of Dutch poplar wood. They are comfortable all year round, keeping your feet warm in winter and cool in summer.

Safety

What safety hazards do the Poplars pose?

There are no real safety hazards with the Poplars. But since they are wooden shoes, they do not stick to your feet as normal shoes would and are heavier to wear. Be careful when trying to run in them.

Maintenance

What do I need to pay attention to when maintaining the Poplars?

The Poplars require no specific maintenance. We recommend treating the nude Poplars with a wood oil for easier cleaning and to prolong the lifespan.

How important is maintenance to the Poplars?

Regularly clean the Poplars and treat the nude shoe with a wood oil to prolong the lifespan and keep them looking new.

Which cleaning products can I use on the Poplars?

Wipe off any dirt with a soft and damp cleaning cloth.

Weather conditions

Which weather conditions will the Poplars withstand?

The Poplars are suitable to wear in any weather condition and will keep your feet warm in winter and cool in summer.

Material

What materials do the Poplars consist of?

The Poplars are made of Dutch poplar wood, as per tradition when it comes to wooden shoes.

How much do the Poplars weigh?

The Poplars weigh 600 to 700 grams per pair.

In what sizes do the Poplars come?

The Poplars are available in the following shoe sizes:
36-37, 38-39, 40-41, 42-43, 44-45.

Are the Poplars comfortable to wear?

Like any clog, it takes some time to get used to wearing a wooden shoe. The Poplars are provided with a footbed and a wooden sole that curves up at the toe, making them as comfortable as possible.

Packaging

How will the Poplars be packaged?

The Poplars are packaged in a cardboard box.

What packaging materials are used?

Cardboard.
